## **Church Nursery Worker**

North Modesto Church of God (NMCHOG) exists to demonstrate Jesus Christ to our world by being a community of servant leaders.

The purpose of NMCHOG is:

- Worship the Lord wholeheartedly
- Train and equip followers to become lifelong disciples of Jesus Christ
- Encourage one another to serve the Lord with our spiritual gifts and abilities
- Create and enhance a healthy environment among its members for the growth of the Kingdom of God
- Reach out and impact our community by being examples of the love of Christ

### **POSITION DESCRIPTION**

- The Nursery Worker is responsible to provide dependable, safe, secure, and nurturing care to children ages 0-4 years while maintaining a clean, safe environment.
- This is a part-time position – see Work Hours section.
- In addition to the responsibilities of the position, the Nursery Worker is in a visible role at NMCHOG, creating a welcoming environment for those visiting and bringing children for care at our church. The person in this position should be a Christian who feels “called to Christian service” and is dedicated to supporting the mission and goals of the church.

### **RESPONSIBILITIES INCLUDE:**

- Provide age-appropriate care including: feeding, changing diapers, escorting to restroom, putting children down for naps, holding, or sitting with, and cheerfully interacting with children through games, stories, play and prayer. Universal precautions should always be used while changing diapers or time of body fluids.
- Stay until the children are secured with a responsible adult as named on the child’s registration form.
- Maintain a clean, safe environment. Straighten the room and clean any toys before leaving. All toys that have had contact with saliva will require special attention. A sanitizing solution will be available to use in the nursery.
- In event of emergency, notify the parent/guardian via designated communication system (Cell phone/pager).

### **PROFESSIONAL EXPECTATIONS AND QUALIFICATIONS:**

- Possess a positive attitude, a quick smile, and strong interpersonal skills
- Be polite, friendly, and courteous to all children, parents, and volunteers
- Collaborates well with others, but can also be effective working independently
- Experience in caring for children between the ages of 0 to 4, with the ability to adapt and interact with a variety of personalities
- Minimum 18 years of age
- Satisfactory completion of fingerprint and background check
- Proof of current (within 1 year) Tuberculin and current immunizations
- Proof of CPR training certification
- Three references (personal and/or professional)
- Bilingual English/Spanish fluency preferred

### **WORK HOURS AND PAID TIME:**

- Beginning at 2+ hours per week. Main child care hours are during Sunday Morning Service, which begins at 10am. Arrive 20 minutes prior to beginning of Service.
- Pay range = \$10-\$12 per hour depending on qualifications and experience.
- Expectations for working all Sundays, including holidays. Occasional options for additional work during special activities & church events, such as Easter & Christmas musicals, Vacation Bible School, etc. The opportunity for extra work will be announced at least 4 weeks prior to the event.
- Attend an evaluation after a 90 day probationary period and minimum annually thereafter.
- Report to nursery coordinator any issues.
- Communicate to nursery coordinator:
  - any planned absences, with two week advance notice
  - any unplanned absences at least two hours prior to the shift
