We are seeking a person who is passionate for Jesus Christ and passionate about students coming to know Jesus Christ. A person that has a strong personal relationship with God, high moral character, integrity and skills to fulfillment this call.

RESPONSIBILITIES CONCERNING THE YOUTH AND YOUNG ADULT MINISTRY

- Develop and lead a thriving ministry to students and young adults
- Provide sound spiritual instruction and development for students and young adults
- Establish a solid Christian faith for students to possess as their own when they graduate
- Build relationships with the youth and individuals in the church and in the community
- Develop relationships with local school officials and be available to visit the schools to help whatever is good and possible in order to be a blessing for them
- Coordinate activities it relates to youth (IYC= International Youth Conventions, camps, mission trips and opportunities to serve the community, etc.)
- Planning, organizing and implementing significant fundraisers to enable students to earn part of the cost of youth conventions, camps or retreats.
- Lead and participate in all youth ministry activities as necessary in order to develop a critical relationship with each student and a link to their parents as well

- Lead our youth and their families in such a way to create and make the most of opportunities to reach families outside of the church for Christ, turning our student ministry into an effective evangelistic force

GENERAL AND CHURCH MINISTRY RESPONSIBILITIES

- Support the Lead Pastor in the overall vision casting and leadership of the church's teaching, and in the evaluating church programs.
- Attend weekly staff meetings for organization, accountability and to review the adherence and development of this position description.
- Planning with the Lead Pastor the yearly calendar of events around a life-giving rhythm.
- Take part in Sunday morning services as needed
- Deliver occasional messages based on scheduling.
- Support the Lead Pastor with weddings, funerals, counseling sessions and visitation.
- Support the Lead Pastor in evaluating church programs
- Visibility in the community and in attendance at appropriate community events
- Maintain personal spiritual disciplines that nurture your heart and soul pursuing a personal plan of professional growth
- Complete other assignments given by the Lead Pastor when needed.
- If married, keep your spouse and kids as your first ministry focus.
- Bring honor to Christ and North Modesto Church of God in daily life and choices.
- Stay physically and emotionally healthy through nutrition, exercise and healthy relationships.
